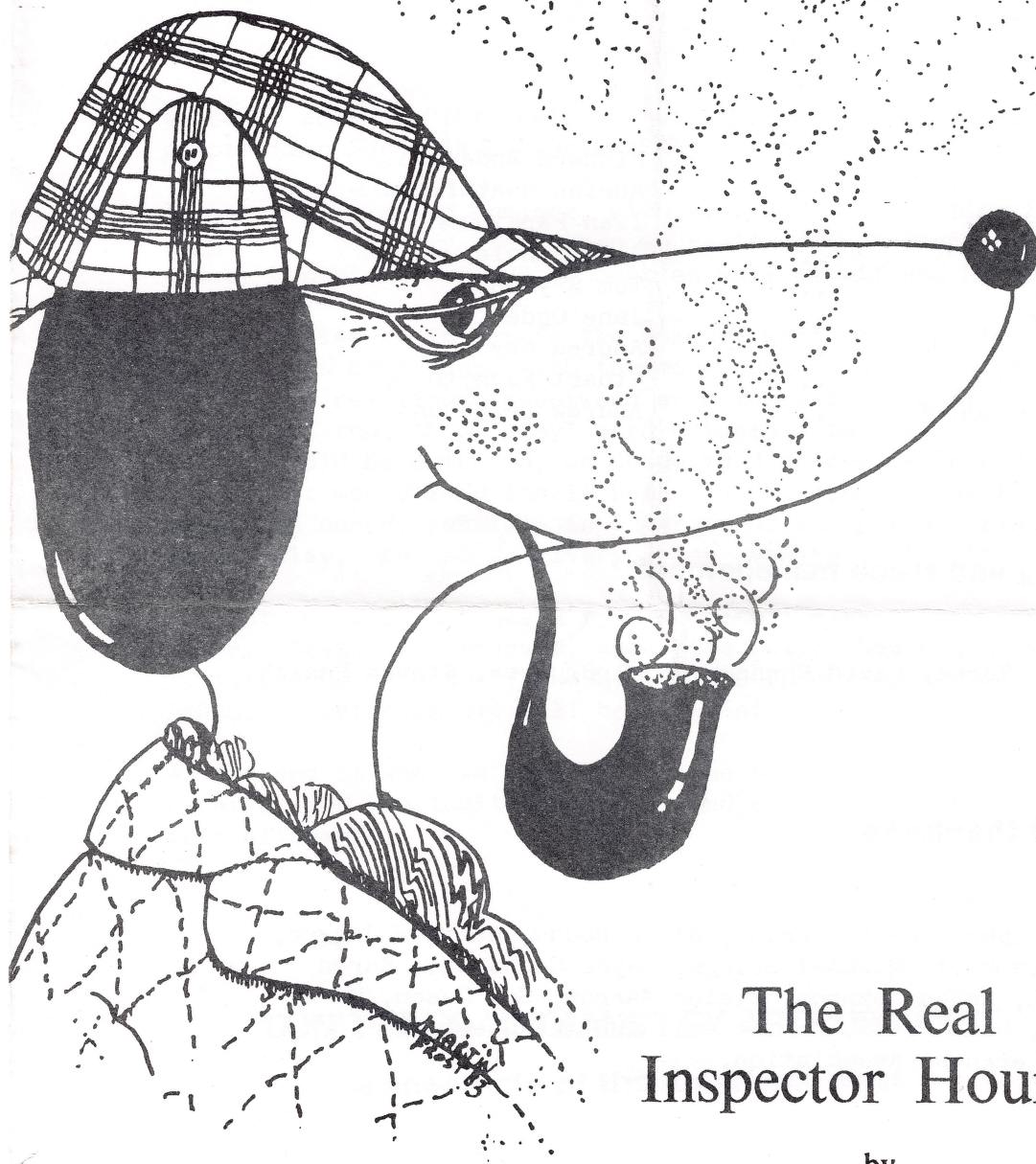

We began work on "The Real Inspector Hound" in September in preparation for this production at Christmas.

It has been a group project, with everyone contributing ideas, right from the very start when we realized that Stoppard's comedy contained serious comment as well as wit and humour.

We have tried to integrate the humour, whether slapstick or satire, pun or parody, with the more serious aspect of the play - the relationship between an actor and his audience. We thought that this 'grey' area between actor, audience and critic could be extended, so we decided to create an atmosphere that would lend itself both to this concept and the situation comedy possible in a parody of an Agatha Christie murder play. And so we give you 'an evening at the theatre'.

Tonight you will not see a typical school play in the normal sense. Seats are reserved; usherettes will show you to your seats in the 'theatre'; and during the interval, typical 'theatre' refreshments will be on sale.
