# **Whittington Green Award**

Like many other schools, there is a growing number of young people who cannot currently successfully access education due to social and emotional difficulties and the challenges faced with having special educational needs.

Whittington Green School is passionate about getting these amazing students with incredible potential back into a classroom environment by the use of the outdoors. By using the outdoors as a classroom, students are provided our students with an experience of outdoor sports and team building activities developing their resilience, confidence and social skills to get them back into classroom.

Whittington Green is fortunate in having a large amount of outdoor space on site, albeit in need of some renovation work. Alongside the large sports field, there is horticultural / agricultural space and the use of a polytunnel.

Using these facilities, the School would like to provide students with methods of supporting their local community and is looking at improving health through growing fruit and vegetables to feed students within the school and support those in need in the surrounding area.
