Annual Reunion – FRIDAY May 6th 2022

We are delighted that, after the cancellation of the 2020 and 2021 events due to the impact of Covid-19, this year's Annual Reunion will take place at the Technique Stadium, 1866 Sheffield Road, Chesterfield, S41 8NZ, on Friday 6th May 2022.

Attendees may meet from 18.00 arriving by 19.15 to allow dinner to be served promptly at 19.30; lounge suits please. The venue closes at 23:30.

The cost this year has had to be increased to £35 for the three-course meal. It had been hoped to hold it at £30 but recent increases due to the impact of the attack by Russia on Ukraine have made this impossible. Special dietary requirements can be accommodated; please indicate this requirement on the form below.

Tickets are to be purchased by **April 22nd**. Physical tickets will not however be issued to minimise cost.

On this occasion, our President, David Allsop BA (Hons), will be installing as his successor John Drabble. John was at School from 1960 to 1967, becoming Large House Captain, and then studied physics at Imperial College, London. After graduation he pursued an IT career with Blue Circle Cement becoming UK IT Manager adding certain European and cross business responsibilities after the takeover of BCI by Lafarge SA. Following discussions at the 2009 Reunion, he was instrumental in creating the Old Cestrefeldians' website and has continued to maintain and expand it since.
