The Old Cestrefeldians' Trust, do have a strong relationship with the Chesterfield College and the planting of the oak tree will be a physical symbol of this ongoing relationship.

If you wish to attend, please ensure you are on the front car park, adjacent to the Clock Tower, by 14:00hr at the latest. As stated before, unfortunately there will be no parking available at the site.
